

Five steps to being a successful MOUSE Squad Student Tech volunteer

- 1) Once you have received your login and password, review the MOUSE Squad curriculum before you visit the school site.
 - Knowing what the students are learning will make you more effective in the classroom.
- 2) When working with students, support them in figuring out the "right" answer, if there is one.
 - Assist them in learning to "logic out" a solution.
- 3) <u>Talk to the instructor about how you can assist;</u> and look for ways that you can help also.
 - Look for ways to contribute to students' learning and the instructor's objectives.

4) Be flexible.

- Classes and teachers often have unexpected challenges and changes in plans. i.e. The Internet is unavailable, a bomb scare or fire drill, half the students are out with the flu...
- Be prepared, and also be ready to change your plans!

5) Have Fun.

 Your interest in the students and the material, and the enthusiasm that you bring influences the students – sometimes in ways you do not see right away.
